

Background information on China-Singapore Friendship Library

The China-Singapore Friendship Library was recently opened to the public on 18 September 2018. Cyberian Ventures Private Limited⁹ has designed two sections in the Library, namely the Singapore Section and the Children’s Eco-Library.

2 The Singapore Section will serve as a one-stop venue for visitors interested in finding out more about Singapore. It can house up to 60,000 volumes of books, magazines and audio-visual materials in both English and Chinese.

3 The Singapore Section also houses the China-Singapore Friendship Gallery, jointly curated by the Ministry of National Development and the National Heritage Board. The gallery features an exhibition that chronicles the journey of Singapore and China working together to build the Sino-Singapore Tianjin Eco-city, and snapshots of Singapore’s history and development.

4 The Children’s Eco-Library, which has taken reference from the National Library Board’s MyTreeHouse Library in Singapore’s Central Library, is designed to raise the eco-consciousness of its visitors. It can house up to 150,000 volumes of books, magazines and audio-visual materials. Singapore-themed library materials for children will also be available in the Children’s Eco-Library.
