Observations

The following observation(s) were considered when deriving the CG scoring and banding for the TCs listed below. TCs which are not listed here did not have any observations recorded for their FY2022 CG bandings.

a) Aljunied-Hougang TC

The TC had a non-compliance with the Town Councils Financial Rules. For the quarter ending March 2023, the TC did not complete the required transfers to its Lift Replacement Fund (LRF) and Sinking Fund (SF) bank accounts by the statutory deadline. This was mainly due to a computation method by the TC which resulted in a shortfall of funds transferred to the LRF and SF respectively. The shortfall was rectified by the TC subsequently.

As the non-compliance was a first-time administrative oversight that had been rectified, it was considered as a low severity observation. This being the only observation for FY2022, the TC scored 0.5 points for its CG scoring. As the total scores for the TC was less than 1 point, the TC was banded "Green".

b) Chua Chu Kang TC

The TC had two instances of non-compliance with the Town Councils Act. The TC did not seek Minister's approval prior to commencing works on non-common property and disbursing funds for the said works for two projects. Minister's retrospective approval for these two projects was sought and given to the TC subsequently.

Both instances were cases of administrative oversight that have since been rectified. There being more than one instance of the same type of non-compliance, this was considered as a medium severity observation. This being the only observation for FY2022, the TC scored 1 point for its CG scoring and was banded "Amber".

c) East Coast TC

The TC had a non-compliance with the Town Councils Act. The TC did not seek HDB's landowner's consent prior to commencing works on common property. HDB's retrospective consent for the project was sought and given to the TC subsequently.

As the non-compliance was a first-time administrative oversight that had been rectified, it was considered as a low severity observation. This being the only observation for FY2022, the TC scored 0.5 points for its CG scoring. As the total scores for the TC was less than 1 point, the TC was banded "Green".

d) Jurong-Clementi TC

The TC had a non-compliance with the Town Councils Financial Rules. Two tender contracts accepted by a committee were not circulated to the TC members for information. The TC had subsequently circulated the tender contracts to the TC members in September 2023.

As the non-compliance was a first-time administrative oversight that had been rectified, it was considered as a low severity observation. This being the only observation for FY2022, the TC scored 0.5 points for its CG scoring. As the total scores for the TC was less than 1 point, the TC was banded "Green".

e) Marsiling-Yew Tee TC

The TC had a non-compliance with the Town Councils Act. The TC did not seek Minister's approval prior to commencing works on non-common property and disbursing funds for the said works. Minister's retrospective approval for the project was sought and given to the TC subsequently.

As the non-compliance was a first-time administrative oversight that had been rectified, it was considered as a low severity observation. This being the only observation for FY2022, the TC scored 0.5 points for its CG scoring. As the total scores for the TC was less than 1 point, the TC was banded "Green".
