CPF Housing Grants are extended to singles

2001

Singles are allowed to buy 3-room and smaller resale flats in all locations

2004

Singles are allowed to buy 4- and larger resale flats in all locations

2013

 Singles are allowed to purchase new 2-room Flexi BTO flats directly from HDB

2019

 Enhanced CPF Housing Grant (EHG) of up to \$40,000 in 2019 introduced for singles

2022

 Increase quota for singles applying for new 2-room Flexi flats in non-mature estates from 50% to 65%

2023

• CPF Housing Grant (Singles) increased from \$25,000 to up to \$40,000
