Sino-Singapore projects in the agreements signed on 13 October 2015

1) Demonstration City for Water Resources Management

Singapore and China will cooperate on promoting the Eco-city as a demonstration city for the management of water resources. This is achieved through collaboration in urban planning and exchanges in the areas of water harvesting capacities, water security and water conservation awareness.

2) Smart City development

The Eco-city aims to be a leader not only in eco-development but also to be a Smart City of world-class standards. Singapore and China will collaborate in areas such as Smart City master planning and information and communication technology capability development, to create a liveable city where residents are more engaged and empowered through smart technologies.

3) Green Building Demonstration Base

The Eco-city has achieved its Key Performance Indicator of having 100% green buildings. Singapore and China will continue to work closely to promote the Eco-city as a Green Building Demonstration Base for showcasing green building products, research and development, education and training.

4) Garden project

Singapore and China will develop a garden in the Eco-city, with Singapore providing its expertise in the planning and design. The garden, planned to be around 66 hectares, will be in the Eco-city's central district and will be an iconic landmark.

5) Library collaboration

Singapore and China will collaborate to develop a new main library in the Eco-city. There will be a Singapore Gallery in the library with books and materials on Singapore. Eco-city residents and people from other parts of Tianjin can visit the library to learn more about Singapore.
