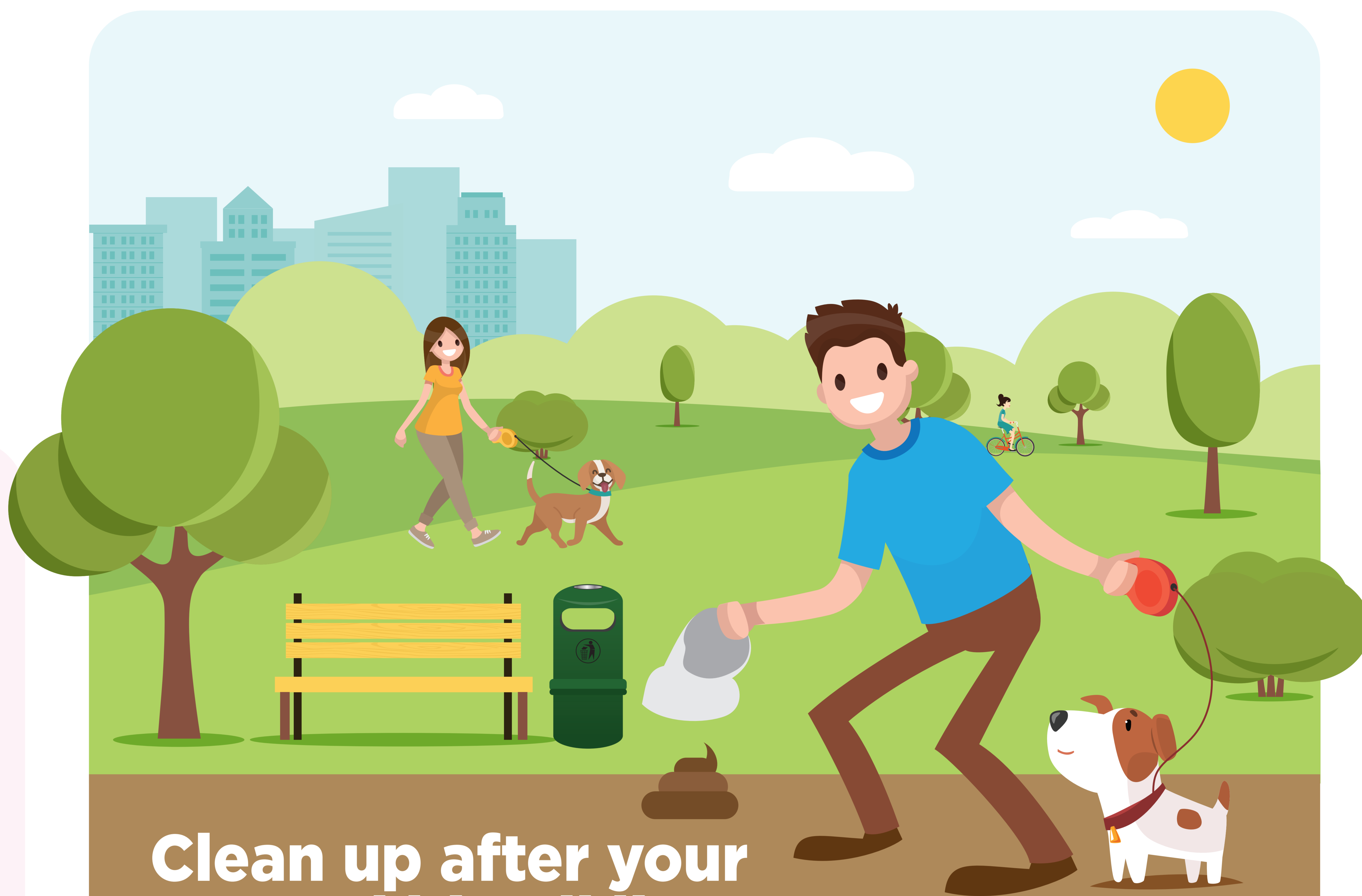

Leaving animal waste behind is unhygienic and causes the area to smell bad.



Under the Environmental Public Health Act, it is an offence to leave behind your dogs' poo and owners who do not clean up after their pets in public areas can be fined up to \$1,000 if caught.



Clean up after your pet and bin all litter

When walking your dog in public areas, bring along a small plastic bag or a piece of newspaper to clear your dog's poo and dispose of it into litter bins.



Wash away your dog's pee

Don't forget to bring along a bottle of water to wash away your dog's pee on concrete surfaces in public areas. If left dirtied, the smell will attract other dogs to pee in the same place too. So do your part because no one likes a smelly pathway or void deck!
