## WHAT HAPPENS WHEN YOU FEED PIGEONS?

### Pigeon droppings soil public amenities and spread diseases

Their droppings stain homes and public amenities. Pigeons also carry diseases that can be contracted by humans through contact with diseased live birds, their droppings and their carcasses. Those with lower immunity (e.g. children and the elderly) will be more vulnerable.



### The population of pigeons increases

Feeding the pigeons in your neighbourhood only encourages them to stay and breed. They will return to the same spot if fed. This leads to overpopulation and an unsightly mess.



### Leftover food attracts pests

Leftover food scraps will attract more pests, like cockroaches and rats, that may carry diseases and pose a risk to public health.
